MINUTES

LANDMARK APPLICATIONS:

LOHR PUROIL SERVICE STATION – It was moved by Ms. Merten, second by Ms. Schroeder that the landmark narrative was finalized following minor changes and following approval of Mr. and Mrs. Schlieve, County Clerk Jaszewski will arrange for the typesetting of the sign. Motion carried.

SCHUBERT CHEESE FACTORY –It was moved by Ms. Merten, second by Ms. Schroeder that the Schubert Cheese Factory landmark application be placed on hold indefinitely until applicants respond to requests for further information. Motion carried.

THE BROWN DOG – Owner Aaron Fuhreck presented copies of the 1859 assessment/tax roll. According to the assessment differences between 1857, 1858, and 1859, it was determined that the house was under construction in 1857. Mr. Fuhreck also presented copies of census and infantry records for Civil War veterans Mr. Mann and Mr. Fitzner who resided in this home in the 1800s. Mr. Fuhreck will create a sign draft narrative prior to the May 7, 2007, landmarks meeting.

LANDMARKS DRIVING TOUR MAPS

Commission members will begin to review each municipality driving tour maps to make additions and corrections. All properties and sites with landmark status will be included in the revisions.

COMMISSION MEMBERS
