

**MINUTES – MEETING 143**  
**WASHINGTON COUNTY LANDMARKS COMMISSION**  
**May 4, 2009**  
**WASHINGTON COUNTY COURTHOUSE**

PRESENT: Chairperson Marilyn Merten, Irene Blau, Eileen Densow, Norbert Dettmann, Marilyn Filber, Robert Meyer, Beverly Schroeder. Kathie Shaver and Barbara Wenzlaff. Also present: Pam Erdmann, Club Commodore, Cedar Lake Yacht Club; Lou Dettmann.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Marilyn Merten at 2:00 p.m. The meeting was properly posted and noticed to the media.

**MINUTES:** Minutes of March 9, 2009, were corrected to list proper name of the landmark application as **Peter's Country Store & Blacksmith Shop/Homestead**. Moved by Ms. Schroeder and seconded by Ms. Shaver, to approve the minutes of the March 9, 2009, as corrected. Motion carried.

**APPLICATIONS:** Pam Erdman, Club Commodore, filed an application for landmark status for the **Cedar Lake Yacht Club**. Robert Meyer, Club Commodore 1958-59, explained that the Club was founded in 1899 and is located on Cedar Lake, the largest lake in Washington County. Mr. J. A. Kiegenmeister was the first Club Commodore. This year the Club celebrates 110 years of organized sailing. The membership consists of over 400 sailors (250 adult members & family members), ranging in age from 4 to 80 years old who sail for pleasure and races and judged for trophies as points are accumulated to the end of the season. The application will be held for review for the 60 day waiting period. It was moved by Ms. Schroeder, seconded by Mr. Meyer to accept the landmark application for Cedar Lake Yacht Club. Motion carried.

**Messer-Mayer Mill Landmark plaque:** It was brought to the attention of the Commission that the Richfield Historical Society has requested an alternate method of displaying the landmark plaque on their property. The Commission recommended that one of two methods of display be used: attached the plaque to the building (secured inside the building) or attach to an iron post set into concrete.

**SAVVY SENIORS PUBLICATIONS:** The Kewaskum Statesman SAVVY SENIORS Spring 2009 free newspaper has been published but no landmark article was featured.

**WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIR 2009:** The County Fair is July 21-26, 2009. The landmarks booth schedule was available.
