SCHUBERT CHEESE FACTORY APPLICATION

Gary Zurn brought a cover from a cheese box bearing the name and location of the Schubert Cheese Factory, Slesingerville, Wis. The Commission took no action to approve the landmark until copies of documents can be obtained pertaining to the operation of the cheese factory. A letter from Mr. Quick, who was not in attendance, was reviewed regarding the renovated structure, mainly the siding, gable, and windows. Mr. Zurn referenced his photos taken prior to the renovation which indicate an accurate renovation. Minor changes were made on the plaque narrative.

WINTER FARM LANDMARK SIGN

Payment for the landmark plaque was received from Laurie Hassinger and the order was placed with Erie Landmark on May 10, 2006.

LANDMARK APPLICATION

Gary and Kathleen Schlieve, landmark applicants for the Lohr Puroil Service Station, City of Hartford, corrected the date of construction to be 1929. Commission members request a complete genealogy of landowners of this property dating back to the original plat of the City of Hartford.

OTHER BUSINESS

County Clerk Jaszewski will forward a letter and application to Garret and Pam Terpstra, City of Hartford, who wish to apply for landmark recognition on their home.

Members had discussion in regard to the County Board appointment to fill the remainder of Joan Baumgartner's term, who resigned.
