LANDMARK APPLICATION

Gary and Kathleen Schlieve, landmark applicants for the Lohr Puroil Service Station, City of Hartford, appeared before the Commission. Additional information was obtained from city tax rolls showing the assessment of new improvements in the late 1920's. Commission members requested that Mr. and Mrs. Schlieve forward copies of deeds and transfers, beginning with the original purchase from the U.S. Government to the present owners, to complete the property genealogy.
