PUBLIC HEARING

The Washington County Highway Department, Part of Sections 10, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21 & 22, Town of Farmington - Conditional Use Permit for excavating, filling or grading in a Shoreland/Wetland/Floodplain Zoning District (Address: The project will extend on County Highway H, from approximately State Highway 144 east to the Milwaukee River)

Appearance: Jon Edgren, Highway Commissioner

Ms. Doro read the Notice of Public Hearing. Mr. Gaudet presented a plat map indicating the location of the project. The Washington County Highway Department is requesting approval of a conditional use permit to reconstruct CTH H, which involves wetland filling and mitigation. A total of 3.90 acres of wetland fill is proposed as part of the project. The Highway Department is proposing to mitigate a total of 11.57 acres of wetland. The proposed reconstruction of CTH H and associated wetland filling is in the Wallace Creek sub-watershed. The proposed wetland mitigation site is in the Stoney Creek sub-watershed. Section 23.03(3) (c) 3 requires the wetland mitigation to be in the same sub-watershed as the wetland filling; however, the wetland mitigation is in the same watershed, which is the Milwaukee North Branch watershed. A floodplain study has been completed for the impacts of the proposal on the 100-year floodplain and has been reviewed and approved the DNR. Mr. Stern opened the public hearing. No comments were received. Mr. Stern closed the public hearing. Moved by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Ewert to approve the Conditional Use permit for excavating, filing or grading in a Shoreland/Wetland/Floodplain Zoning District for the Washington County Highway Department, Sections 10, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21 & 22, Town of Farmington. Motion carried.
