- Committee. The current City ordinance for open parks and trail hours is 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. and the 26
- City does not allow dogs in their parks or on trails. The City is requesting that the County consider and 27
- enforce their ordinance on the five-mile section of the Eisenbahn Trail that runs through the City of West 28
- Bend. Staff recommends that the County's rules and ordinance remain in force for the entire Eisenbahn 29
- trail located within the County. Staff does not object to 6:00 a.m. as a countywide opening time for all 30

- representatives Sue Millin and Shawn Graff, who were present to provide input on the development of a 46
- task force. Mr. Johnson commented on the financial aspect of the proposed program. Mr. Graff indicated 47
- the Land Conversation Partnership has some funds that could be used for administrative needs of the 48
- proposed task force. 49
