25 **MEDICAL EXAMINER TRANSFERS**

33 **JAIL POPULATION REPORTS**

34 Sheriff Rahn stated today there are 203 adults, 26 of them are female, and 23 on electronic monitoring
35 and five of these are female. Today there are three juveniles and two are from Ozaukee County. For the
36 month of February the daily average was 219 with 22 on electronic monitoring. The February female
37 daily average was 20. The daily average for juvenile population was 12.11, 6.79 out of county, 3.04 were
38 female. There were 183 billable juvenile days in February for revenue of \$21,045 from Ozaukee, Dodge,
39 Dane and Jefferson counties. There were 21 Juvenile Court Intakes with five of them being custody
40 intakes, three of them were in Secure Detention and two held in Shelter.

42 **DEPARTMENT HIRING/STAFFING UPDATE – SHERIFF**

43 Eight people wrote the Detective exam, six passed. Interviews for the two openings will take place
44 Thursday, March 9, 2006. Eleven people wrote the Sergeant exam, ten passed and interviews will take
45 place March 27, and 28, 2006. Patrol will need three new individuals. Corrections will have one opening
46 and staff interviews will take place within the next two weeks.

48 **WIRELESS E-911 UPDATE**

49 R.A. Smith has started the mapping and point addressing, which is the database that will overlay the
50 mapping for the Wireless 911. The contract has been signed, and R.A. Smith is ahead of schedule.
