30 **REVIEW ORDINANCE RELATING TO VEHICLE USE AND MILEAGE**
31 **REIMBURSEMENT FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

32 Mr. Schmid explained to the Committee the Emergency Management’s position regarding the
33 2004 Ordinance 37 – An Ordinance to repeal Section 4.20(5) of the code; relating to: Vehicle
34 Use; to amend Section 7.03(5) relating to: Mileage; and to create Section 7.16 of the code;
35 relating to: Use of County Owned Vehicles. Discussion followed regarding Emergency
36 Management’s use of a county-owned vehicle.

38 Moved by Mr. Berchem, seconded by Mr. Esselmann to approve 2004 Ordinance 37 as presented,
39 and forward to the County Board. Motion carried.

41 **JAIL REPORT**

42 Sheriff Rahn reported the jail population at 185 adults, 22 female, 14 on the electronic
43 monitoring. Juvenile population is 10 with 3 of those being females, 7 of those are from
44 Washington County and 3 are from out of county.

46 Sheriff Rahn informed the Committee that they are in the new pod area, special needs special
47 management area.

49 Sheriff Rahn stated that he received a resignation from Diane Schneider, Correctional Officer
50 who has been with the County for 20 years. Ms. Schneider will retire in April of 2005.

53 Sheriff Rahn presented two 2005 transfer requests for his department.

55 Moved by Mr. Esselmann, seconded by Mr. Gonnering to approve the 2005 transfer requests for
56 the Sheriff’s Department as presented. Motion carried.

58 Sheriff Rahn updated the Committee on the indoor shooting range project, which should be
59 completed by the end of March 2005. Mr. Gonnering suggested that at a future Public Safety
60 meeting, the Committee should do a walk through of the shooting range.

62 Sheriff Rahn spoke to the committee on Assembly Bill 76, cell phone usage.

64 Captain Schmidt updated the committee on the Wireless 911 system.
