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23 **STATUS ON VIDEO CONFERENCING USAGE**

24 Appearance: Judge David Resheske, Clerk of Courts Kristine Deiss

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26 Ms. Deiss distributed and discussed the status on Video Conferencing Hearings held in 2008 and January 1,  
27 2009, through June 30, 2009. Ms. Deiss informed the committee that more routine hearings are using  
28 videoconferencing instead of moving suspects from other counties for brief court appearances, and they  
29 estimate videoconferencing will save about \$20,000 a year. Most of this would be in prisoner transportation  
30 costs.

32 Judge Resheske said he and his fellow judges are willing to use videoconference when at all possible, but  
33 sometimes there are some scheduling problems.

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35 Mr. Miller suggested that Judge Resheske encourage the other judges to use it as much as possible.

4 with 1.71 of those being borders. There were 412 jail bookings in July.
