**JAIL POPULATION**

Sheriff Schmidt reported for the month of October, the average daily adult inmate population was 228,  
the Huber daily average was 131, the electronic monitoring daily average was 6.94, and the juvenile daily  
average was 9.71, with 5.39 of those being borders.

**COMMUNICATIONS**

Sheriff Schmidt reported for the month of September, Dispatch received 1,417 wireless 911 calls, 204  
landline 911 calls, and 3,523 administrative calls.

**FATALITY**

Sheriff Schmidt reported there were 4 fatalities in September for a total of 13 for 2010.
