15 Chairperson Tennes called the meeting to order and read the affidavit of posting.

17 **REVIEW AND REVISE TENTATIVE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT PLANS**

18 Mr. Damkot presented draft plans #10a, #10b, #10c, and #10d.

20 Draft plan #10a is a hybrid of draft plans #4b and #9a. There are 26 districts that have one incumbent
21 each, two districts, one in the City of West Bend and one in the City of Hartford that have no incumbents,
22 and two districts, district 8 and district 13, which have two incumbents. This draft plan keeps rural areas
23 with rural areas and keeps the incorporated areas with incorporated areas. There is a substandard ward
24 issue in the Town of Kewaskum.

26 Mr. Damkot reported draft plans #10b, #10c, and #10d were created specifically to eliminate the
27 contested race in district 13 in 2012. The areas of change are located in the City of West Bend and
28 northern areas. There is a substandard ward issue in the Town of Barton in draft plan #10b.

30 Moved by Mr. Miller seconded by Mr. Myers to eliminate draft plans #10c and #10d. Motion carried.
31 Moved by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Myers to eliminate draft plan #10b. Motion was defeated with
32 Mr. Gundrum, Mr. Core, Mr. Myers, Mr. Stoffel and Mr. Tennes voting no.

34 Moved by Miller, seconded by Mr. Stern to place the importance of creating the maps to protect the
35 integrity of the municipal boundaries. Motion defeated with Mr. Gundrum, Mr. Core, Mr. Myers, and
36 Mr. Stoffel voting no.

38 The meeting recessed at 3:27 p.m. and reconvened at 3:38 p.m.

11 and reconcile the substandard ward issue in the Town of Kewaskum.
