14 Chairperson Tennes called the meeting to order and read the affidavit of posting.

16 **MINUTES**

17 Moved by Mr. Stoffel, seconded by Mr. Gundrum to approve the August 2, 2011, and August 16, 2011,
18 Redistricting minutes as presented. Motion carried.

20 **REVIEW AND REVISE TENTATIVE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT PLANS**

21 Mr. Damkot reported the municipalities did create their wards plans to match the County supervisory
22 district lines. The municipalities impacted by the State adopting their plan in July, have all come up with
23 alternative ward plan solutions. All ward plans are finalized except for the City of Hartford and City of
24 West Bend, but their proposed ward plan will be taken up by their respective Councils and is incorporated
25 in the plan being presented today. Mr. Damkot is not aware of any opposition and does not anticipate any
26 changes from the Cities. There are only two districts that have been changed since the tentative plan was
27 adopted by the County Board back in May. District 5 has one less person in it and District 15 has one
28 more person in it.

30 Ms. Nass distributed 2011 Ordinance 12, which was prepared based on the ward information received
31 after the August 16, 2011, Redistricting Committee meeting and the ward information she received from
32 the City of West Bend and City of Hartford.

34 Ms. Jaszewski reported the City of Milwaukee had to renumber their wards due to changes made by the
35 State, so the City of Milwaukee ward in the Washington County District plan will be renumbered from
36 314 to 318. Ms. Jaszewski reported the City of Milwaukee has not approved their final plan, however,
37 she does not anticipate any opposition to this change.

39 Ms. Nass discussed amending the code to include a process of incorporating new wards that are created
40 after the final supervisory district plan is adopted. It was Committee consensus that the County Clerk
41 should administer this process and the County Attorney would bring an ordinance amendment
42 incorporating this process into the County code for Executive Committee consideration.

44 Moved by Mr. Stern, seconded by Mr. Myers to approve 2011 Ordinance 12 -Supervisor Districts -
45 (2.01), and forward to the County Board. Motion carried.
