WERC appeal update – A mediation session with the union was held 4/6/09, no resolution was reached.

Remodeling Update – All residents on the East side of the building were moved to the west side 4/22 through 4/28; with the additional bathrooms the quarters are even more cramped. We will be sending out letters to the neighbors as is required for the CBRF licensure to invite them to ask questions. A waiver has been granted for the "barn doors" on the bathrooms. A variance is being pursued for the resident bathroom grab-bars and toilet distance from wall.

Golfing fundraiser update – Progress continues in planning the July 20<sup>th</sup> golf outing.

State Budget Update – Mr. Somers contacted representative Strachota and Senator Grothman to advocate on behalf of Samaritan during the budget process.
