

1 **2011 PUBLIC LAND SURVEY SYSTEM (PLSS) MONUMENT MAINTENANCE**
2 **PROGRAM PHASE II – TOWN OF JACKSON PROJECT UPDATE**

3 This project was awarded to Capitol Surveying on August 11, 2011. The contract was returned
4 to the County November 2, 2011, and Capitol Surveying is now starting the project.

6 **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE (INCLUDING AB303)**

7 Mr. Damkot stated that Assembly Bill 303 was passed yesterday and the Bill is now on its way
8 to the Senate. This bill would allow counties and municipalities to opt out of Smart Growth
9 Planning Law, and it would have some significant impact on Washington County if it is passed.

11 **INFORMATION ON LIGHTSQUARED’S APPLICATION TO THE FCC AND**
12 **POSSIBLE IMPACTS ON EXISTING GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEMS**

13 Mr. Schmidt stated that LightSquared is a large company that wants to provide broad band
14 wireless across the entire United States. Other companies would have to come to LightSquared
15 for services. Mr. Damkot stated that details concerning LightSquared are changing daily, and he
16 will keep this Council informed.

18 **WASHINGTON COUNTY GIS WEBSITE UPGRADE STATUS AND**
19 **DEMONSTRATION**

20 Mr. Damkot presented a demonstration of the new GIS website. The main change is the
21 availability of either a general map or an advanced map. The City of West Bend has also been
22 integrated into the system. Website five minute training videos are available on the County
23 website under GIS.
